<p>Arrival (Students)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students should not come to school before 7:45am • Still use current car drop off lanes in Lots A and C <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Lot A is for students in grades Pre-K-2 (if a family has students in multiple grades, it is okay to drop off all students) ○ Lot A is also for students eating school breakfast, enter door 19 ○ Lot B is for parents who wish to park and walk students to their door ○ Lot C is for students in grades 3-5 • Points of entry for students, starting at 7:45am <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Pre-K and Kinder will enter door 2 (left of main entrance) ○ 1-2 will enter door 1 (main entrance) ○ 3-4 will enter door 13 (gym entrance) ○ 5 will enter door 11 (right of gym entrance) • All students entering the building must wear a face covering or mask • Students will head directly to their classrooms and follow classroom procedures • Students arriving late to school will be buzzed into the building and office staff will sign children in
<p>Breakfast</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Breakfast will begin at 7:45am • K-5 students will enter through door 19

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-K students enter through door 2 and eat in their classroom • Students should wash or sanitize hands after depositing trash into trash can • K-1 eat in cafeteria, seating will be designated • 2-5 eat in classrooms and/or pods, seating will be designated
Classroom Environment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assigned seating will be utilized • Classroom teachers will have clearly defined expectations for sharpening pencils, hand sanitizer, etc. • Classroom regulation areas may be used • Students will follow the same guidelines for snack as they follow during lunch
Cleaning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • District is providing cleaning cloths and spray cleaners for all classrooms • Staff and students must sanitize or wash hands every hour • Staff and students (who are allowed) should sanitize and clean spaces frequently throughout the day
Common Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue to limit time spent in these areas, when possible
Communication (Close Contact)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If your child comes in close contact with a person that tests positive for COVID, the school will contact you regarding the procedures to be followed
COVID-Related Symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nurse or designated staff will contact family of sick child <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Parent/Guardian will pick up sick child at door 1 (main entrance) ○ Student will need to be picked up within 30 minutes of being notified
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Points of exit for Grades K-5 at 3:15pm <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Pre-K will exit through door 2 (Dismissal for Pre-K is at 2:30pm) ○ K will exit through door 3 (back of building) ○ 1-2 will exit door 1 (main entrance) ○ 3-4 will exit door 13 (gym entrance) ○ 5 will exit door 11 (right of gym entrance) • Bus Riders- dismiss to the Gym at 3:15pm • Classroom teachers will exit with students on time and walk their students out • Parents/Guardians should not stand on sidewalks, so that students have a larger space to exit • Parents/Guardians need to wait or stand in parking lot (near sidewalk), or along access roads, to pick up students
Face-Coverings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • USD 475 requires all staff, students, and visitors to wear masks, regardless of vaccination status, inside all district facilities and district vehicles, including school buses.
Hand Washing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handwashing/sanitizing will take place hourly
Parent Meetings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent Meetings (IEP, MTSS, 504, etc.) will be held in person when possible

Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will start the year eating in their classrooms in designated spots• All students must sanitize their hands before eating and after depositing trash into trash can
Parents/Guardian Protocols	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Parents/Guardians dropping off materials (lunchbox, backpack...) will buzz the office, drop the item in the wagon at the front door, and an office staff will take the materials to the student
Recess/Social Connection	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Each class will follow a rotation schedule to play in designated zones
Water Bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students need to bring a water bottle, filled with plain water, to school each day• Please label the child's name on the water bottle• Water fountains will not be accessible and water bottles will not be provided
